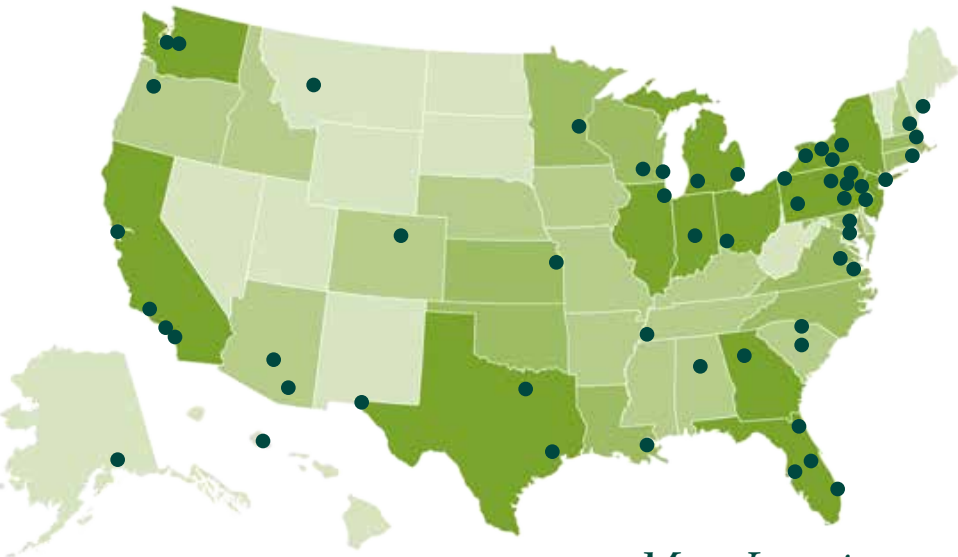

Reciprocal Club Privileges

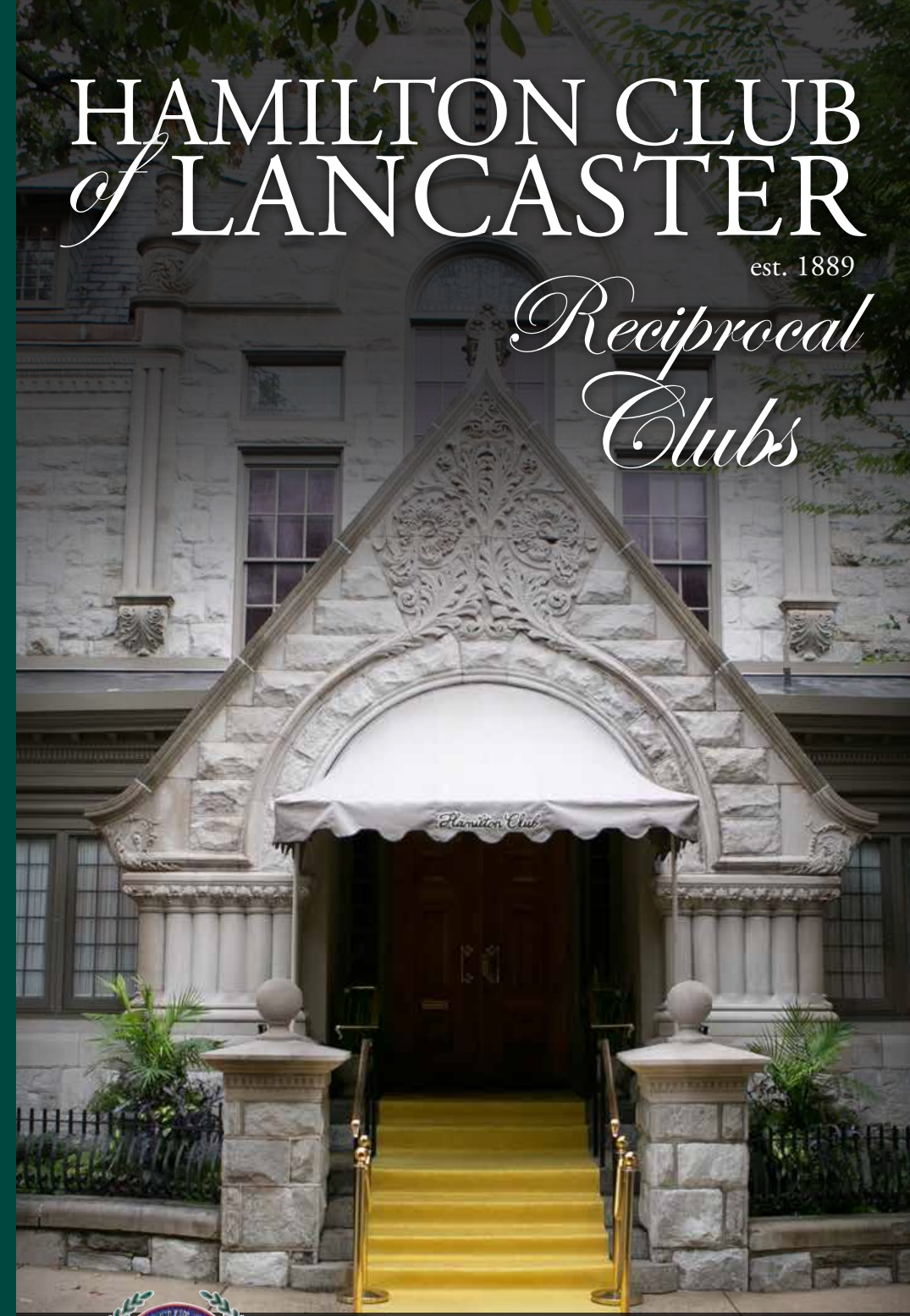
